English

The children will be involved in the following literacy activities:

Writing

- Re-telling traditional stories.
- Considering themes.
- Settings
- Characters.
- Using and writing dictionaries, glossaries, indexes, ordered texts
- Writing instructions
- Writing poetry

Reading

- Read work and check for tense and accuracy
- Learning to use different strategies to tackle unfamiliar words, including breaking up compound words e.g handbag

Phonics

A separate letter will be sent covering this information.

Speaking and Listening

- Speaking clearly
- Re-telling stories using structure
- Speaking in grammatically accurate sentences
- Acting in a role and developing a role.

Mathematics

The children will study and consolidate the following areas of the numeracy framework:

- Place value—Tens and units.
- Estimation and approximation.
- Adding 2 or 3 numbers.
- Work with money using +, -, and x.
- Symmetry.
- Use Kilograms.

Science

This term we will study the following topics:

- Grouping and changing materials including melting & heating.
- Forces and movement—how mechanisms speed up and slow down.
- Variation—similarities between plants & animals & differences within these groups.
- Parts of plants.

Religious Education

- Christianity. Leaders and Teachers.
- How do Jewish people express their beliefs in practice.
- Easter.

ICT (Computers)

- Researching using the internet.
- Creating pictures with technology.
- Learning/developing keyboard skills.

Personal, Social, Health and Citizenship

- Know factors that harm/improve health.
- Respect/Friendship.
- Addressing bullying.

Geography

- Know about the features of different places including climate—Scotland as an alternative locality.

History

- Find out about the past from a range of sources including archaeology.
- What were homes (including castles) like in the past.

Art

- Studying a famous artist.
- Puppets & textiles.
- Art using technology.

Design Technology

- Making a wheeled vehicle.

Physical Education

- Games skills—passing, ball control, tag rugby.
- Dance—creative dance (water & monsters)
- Gymnastics..
